The Livermore-Amador Valley Water Management Agency (LAVWMA) is seeking quotes from qualified vendors to assess, remediate, and certify its public-facing website for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Title II, and California Government Code Sections 7405, 11135, and 11546.7. The goal is to ensure full conformance with **WCAG 2.2 Level AA** standards.

2. Scope of Work

The selected vendor will be responsible for:

- Conducting a comprehensive accessibility audit of the LAVWMA website.
 - Identifying all non-compliant elements and providing a detailed remediation plan.
 - Implementing necessary changes by working with LAVWMA's staff to implement them.
 - Providing documentation and certification of compliance with:
 - ADA Title II
 - California AB 434
 - WCAG 2.2 Level AA
 - Delivering training or documentation for ongoing accessibility maintenance.

- Accessibility widget for UI and design remediation.

- Familiarity with California-specific accessibility laws (e.g., AB 434).
- Use of both automated and manual testing tools (e.g., Axe, WAVE, JAWS, NVDA).
- At least three references from similar projects with government or utility agencies.
